General Statement of Duties:

This is a combination of skilled work in the operation of moderately complex specialized maintenance and construction equipment and unskilled manual work in general maintenance activities.

Work involves responsibility for the safe and efficient operation of assigned equipment to performing light and heavy manual work as needed.

The work of this class differs from that of lower classes of Equipment Operator in that the incumbents must operate heavier, more complex, specialized equipment and several types of equipment within this category interchangeably, and be able to perform manual work and assistance when required.

Work may be performed with considerable independence, but a foreman will regularly check the work performed for quality, quantity, safety of operation, care of equipment and tools used. May be assigned to perform work in other divisions and/or departments.

Supervision Received:

Work is performed under the general supervision of the Operations Supervisor.

Supervision Exercised:

Direct and coordinate lower level operatives as assigned.

Illustrative Duties:

Operates specialized grass mowers (i.e., riding mower, gang mowers).

Operates trucks to plow snow and spread salt and sand on icy roads during snow removal operations.

Instructs lower level operators in the finer points of operation and servicing of assigned equipment.

Operates garbage truck for removal of debris from parks and buildings. Operates tractor and leaf blowers for removal of leaves from all city parks and grounds. Operates SmithCo to grade fields for new turf installation. Operates wood chipper and chain saws for tree trimming and tree cutting.

Makes field repairs to equipment and assists mechanics on major repairs.

Participates in work related to street and storm water sewer maintenance and construction; performs general laboring tasks.

Illustrative Duties: (cont.)

May serve as a substitute operator on heavier equipment, such as motor patrol grader, heavy road roller, bull-dozer, shovel, snow loader, and others.

Maintain ball fields, football field, soccer field; set up and maintain all ball field bleachers.

Set up and maintain all sound equipment for band concerts and festivals.

Install and remove all Christmas light decorations.

Perform related work including lesser manual tasks as required.

Knowledge, Skill and Abilities:

Considerable knowledge of traffic laws and other regulations governing automotive equipment operation.

Considerable knowledge of the operating and repair characteristics of heavy automotive and similar public works equipment.

Considerable knowledge of the components parts, operating principles, and maintenance needs of maintenance and construction equipment.

Ability to service various types of relatively heavy equipment and to make minor running repairs.

Ability to understand and carry out oral and written instructions and to prepare required reports.

Skill in the operation of moderately complex construction and maintenance equipment.

Physical strength and agility sufficient to operate heavy equipment over rough terrain occasionally under adverse weather conditions.

High school graduate or the equivalent. Considerable experience in the operation and maintenance of trucks and other specialized automotive equipment. Or, any equivalent combination of experience and training which provides a demonstrated potential for performing the duties of the position.
